If your carryover is subject to the limit based on 50% of your AGI, you can deduct \$500 of the \$1,000 you carried over, which is 50% of your AGI minus your cash contributions to a 50% limit organization (\$10,000 - \$9,500 = \$500). You can carry over the \$500 balance of your carryover from last year to the next year.

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
