Although the Cubists did not necessarily know about Einstein's theory — Picasso was unaware of Einstein when he created "*Les Femmes d'Alger (O. J. R. M.)*" (1911), an early Cubist painting — they were aware of the popular idea of time travel. They also understood Non-Euclidean geometry, which the artists Albert Gleizes and Jean Metzinger discussed in their book "*Cubism*" (1912).
