The "general" epistles, also known as the "Catholic" epistles (meaning universal, not to a specific church or individual) are the books of 1 and 2 Peter, James, Jude, 1, 2 and 3 John. Sometimes these books can be confusing, particularly James with its message of works which seems to contradict Paul's message of salvation by faith.

Assuming Peter wrote his letter first (AD 64–66), Jude probably wrote his epistle sometime between AD 67 and 80. Why is Jude so important? Jude's edgy brevity communicates the urgency of his notion that false teachers needed to be condemned and removed from the church. Few words meant that Jude would not waste space dancing around the issue.
